#### Overview

Romans is not just for theologians! Paul wrote to ordinary people (see ch16) in a key city, who he hadn't had the opportunity to preach to. He wanted them to be well grounded in the Gospel so that their witness would be most effective – All roads lead to (& from) Rome! For that reason Romans is probably the clearest, most exhaustive exposition of the Gospel and has brought breakthrough to many – Augustine, Martin Luther, Wesley and you?
